Welcome to our Online Farmgate Sale. Thank you to the buyers who supported us in last year's sale and throughout the year. I think everyone is tired of Covid and all the other stresses related to it that we need to be positive and look forward to an improved cattle market and better weather conditions for the following year.

After selecting calves from the top 30% of the calf crop as breeding bulls they are then culled for temperament, performance and fertility throughout the year. They have to be quiet and easy to work with. They are pail fed twice a day and moved to a watering tank daily. The bulls are fed a rolled barley ration at about 1% of their body weight with a balanced mineral pack, silage and free choice hay.

The 2 year old bulls will be semen tested prior to the sale. The yearling bulls will be semen tested towards the end of March when they are a little older and the weather is warmer.

Two year old bulls can remain at the farm until March 31 free of charge. After this date we will charge \$5.00 per day to care for them. The yearling bulls can remain here until April 30 at no charge, then \$3.00 per day. Pick up your bull by March 31 and receive a \$50.00 refund or delivery can be arranged at cost.

We recommend that ALL bulls be insured as each animal becomes the risk of the purchaser as soon as sold.

Look to a two year old bull to run with larger groups of cows without melting down, or to walk in those larger, rangier pastures that a yearling just won't cut it in. Please bid and buy with confidence as these bulls are designed to last and are guaranteed 100%. New for this year 4 pens of 3 commercial open heifers that are represented by each breed as well as a pen of fancy black baldie heifers. These are some of the best open replacement heifers you will find so please study these heifers in great detail. They are also available for viewing on the farm so when you come and see the bulls remember to have a look at the heifers as well, you will want to take every pen home with you! pen home with you!





- 2. You can choose your favourite lots in this sale at this time and the program will allow you to open either all sale lots or just your favorite lots on your screen. Any time there is active bidding on a lot you have identified on your favorite list you will get a text and/or an email noting this activity.
- 3. The program allows you to place a proxy bid on any sale lot.
